### **ENTRY RULES FOR DISPLAY ITEMS:**

1. Items must be **clean and in excellent condition.**
2. The following items will not be accepted: pre-quilted, cheater fabric panels, tied quilts, or quilts that have previously been entered in this show.
3. A **fabric label** with exhibitor's name and address must be sewn on the back of each item.
4. **Entry Sheets** and **Check-In**: Entry Sheets must be turned in by **Saturday, April 28, 2012**. All items to be exhibited should be delivered to the ISU Ballroom on Thursday, May 10, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and picked up at the same location on Saturday, May 21, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. All items must remain in place until the show closes at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.
5. **Early Check-In**: If your quilted items need to be turned in before Thursday, please make arrangements with Sherry Powers, #233-0430.
6. VOTING BY THE PUBLIC WILL CEASE ON SATURDAY, MAY 1, AT 2:00 p.m., so all presentation of awards can be made by 3:30 p.m. The show closes at 5:00 p.m, sharp, and all items must be picked up at 5:30 p.m. Other arrangements for pick-up can be made with Sherry.

### **QUILT BLOCK CHALLENGE CONTEST**

1. Finished block size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" square. Your choice of pattern.
2. \$5 for entry fee and pieces of fabric. Provided is the focus fabric and background fabric, and you can use your choice of other coordinating fabrics. Use no embellishments or applique!
3. **ATTENTION**: YOU MUST USE each piece of FABRIC PROVIDED in your block.
4. **Send entry fee (check made payable to PVQG) to Jeanne Brown, 261 Thurston, Pocatello, Idaho 83201**, and a piece of fabric and instructions will be mailed promptly.
5. **NOTE**: Blocks will not be returned to you. They will become the property of the Portneuf Valley Quilters Guild, and will be used to make the next raffle quilt for the next biennial quilt show.
